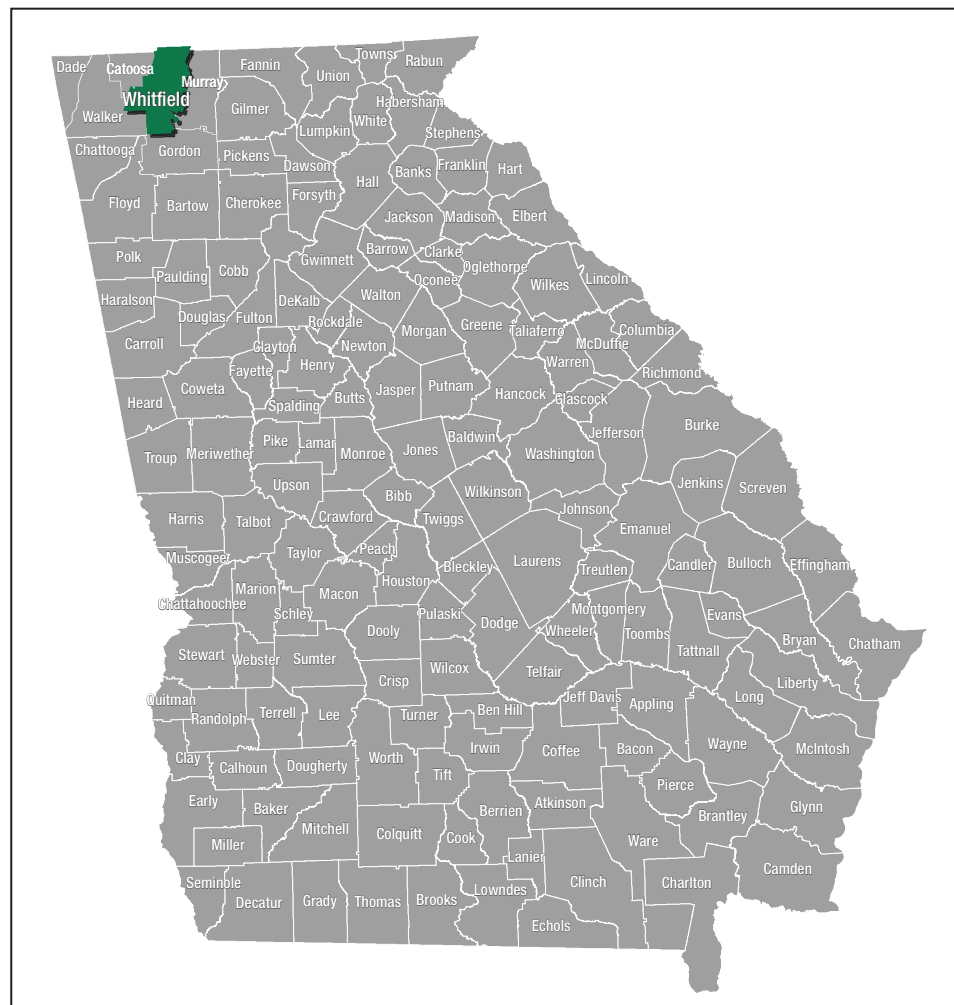

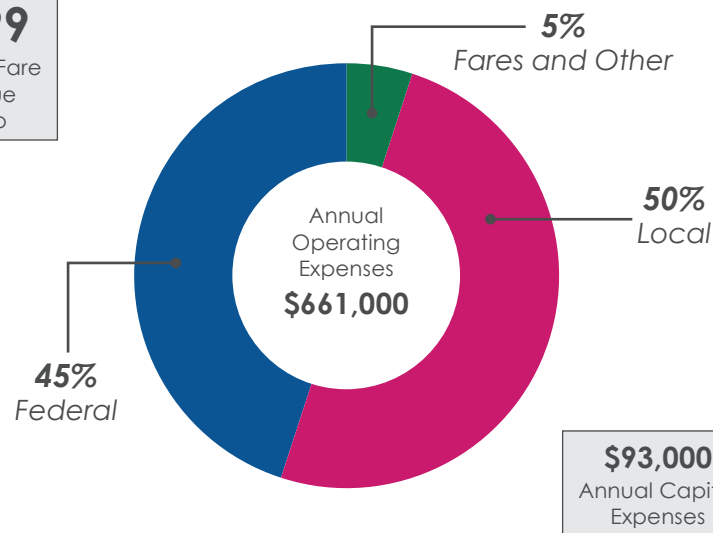

Average Fare Revenue Per Trip

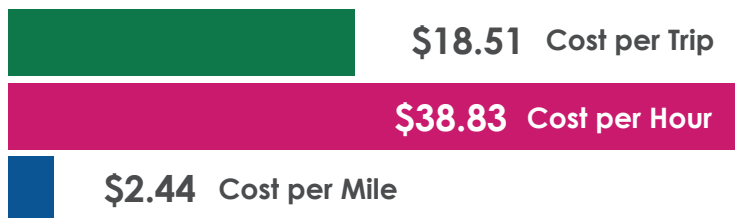
